The purpose of this letter is to provide an update on the status of the suspension of invasive animal research on grant 5 R01 DC007177-09, entitled, "Behavioral and Physiological Studies of Sound Localization." Staff from the NIH and from the USDA recently visited the laboratory and the animal facility associated with this project and met with relevant staff at the University of Wisconsin, Madison.

NIDCD staff members are in communication with NIH OLAW staff about the status of the suspended research activities and it is expected that there will be resolution within the next few weeks; however, an exact date is not yet known. Thus, the restriction on the use of invasive animals in this project remains in effect. The NIDCD will provide written communication when this status changes.
