OLAW has completed its investigation of the allegations of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Primate Products, Inc. (PPI) which you had provided to us on behalf of PETA on June 1, 2015. PPI has made all corrective actions. This was verified by an unannounced joint visit by OLAW and the USDA, APHIS, Animal Care on August 11, 2015.
