

All Pre-and-Post-Meeting COI Certification in IAR Will Be Electronic

Information for Reviewers

For those of you who have reviewed before, you will see changes in the pre-and-post-meeting conflict of interest (COI) certifications in the Internet Assisted Review (IAR) module in the fall of 2018.

Pre-meeting:

1. Read the certifications in IAR and certify at the bottom. Note, the language of the pre-and-post-meeting certifications has been updated, so please read it carefully. You will be presented with the appropriate information, depending on what is being reviewed and whether you are a federal/non-federal reviewer. If the information is not correct, please contact the scientific review officer (SRO).
2. You must sign the pre-meeting COI certification early in the process. If you do not do so, you will not be able to submit critiques, criterion scores and preliminary scores.
3. A recertification will be required if an additional conflict is discovered before the meeting or under other scenarios (meeting date changes and certifications reflect the previous date, etc.).

Post-meeting:

1. The post-meeting COI certification must be electronically signed at the time you complete your participation in the study section meeting. Paper certifications will no longer be accepted.
