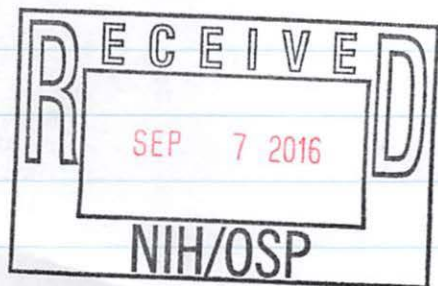
To Whom it May Concern:

NIH has ignored its pledge to "undertake a deliberate process to evaluate the state of the science in this area, the ~~ethical~~ ethical issues that should be considered, and the relevant animal welfare concerns associated with these types of studies" when the moratorium was put into place in 2015.
