
Dear Office of Science Policy Comments:

I object strongly to the NIH's proposal to rescind its moratorium on funding of human-animal chimeras.

This research is ethically problematic and the NIH should give far more serious consideration to the significant ethical problems associated with this research before seeking to fund human-animal chimera research.
